Cremation and inurnment of the cremated remains took place in Camden County Crematory, Waterford Twp.



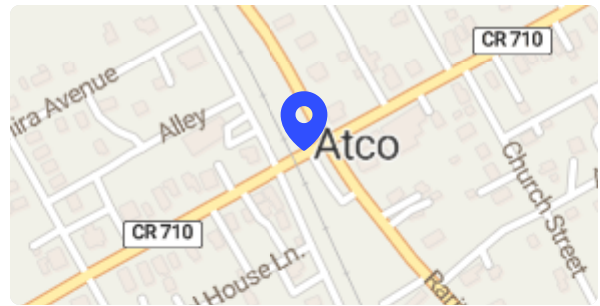

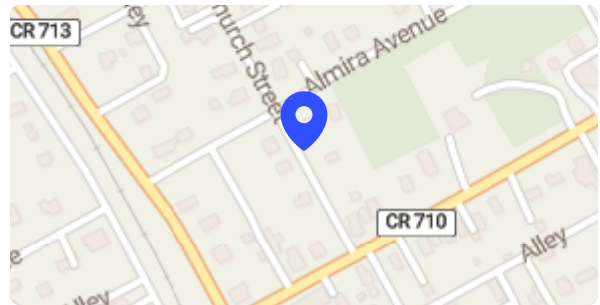

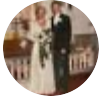
