Charles L. Bryant, aged 88 years of Fairfield Twp., passed away on Monday afternoon January 16, 2017 in J.F.K. Hospital, Stratford after a lengthy illness.

Born in Fairfield Twp. the only child of the late Charles L. and Christiana (nee Pierce) Bryant, and the husband of Lydia M. (nee Gould) Bryant. He and his wife were lifetime area residents.


Charles served proudly in the US Army during the Korean War. After his honorable discharge, he went to work for General Electric in King of Prussia where he spent 27 years as a test specialist in the Aerospace Division. He enjoyed working on and repairing televisions and radios, and also loved playing the guitar, playing chess, and teaching the game to children at church. Charles was a long time member of Trinity A.M.E. Church, Gouldtown. He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather.
