Alice M. Carney, aged 95 years of Hopewell Twp., passed away early Thursday evening February 22, 2018 in Inspira Medical Center, Vineland after an extended illness.

Born in Greenwich Twp. December 13, 1922 to the late John Sr. and Anna (nee Pierce) Coward, and the wife of the late Walter Carney. Mr. and Mrs. Carney had been residents of the Greenwich area all of their lives until moving to Hopewell Twp. in 1968.

Alice was a longtime member of the Centerton Congregation of Kingdom Hall Jehovah's Witnesses. She worked for 40 plus years as the cafeteria manager at the Morris Goodwin School in Greenwich and was actually the first manager, being instrumental in 1956 with the start of a cafeteria in the school. Prior to her employment in the school, she had worked for Gorson and McCormick Produce Market. 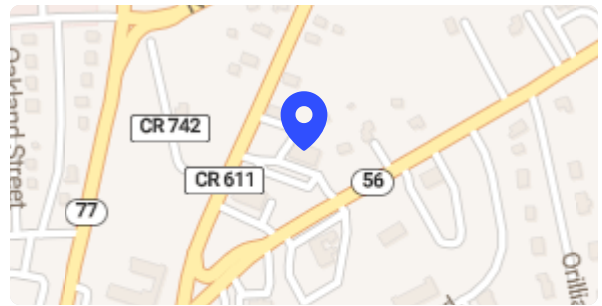

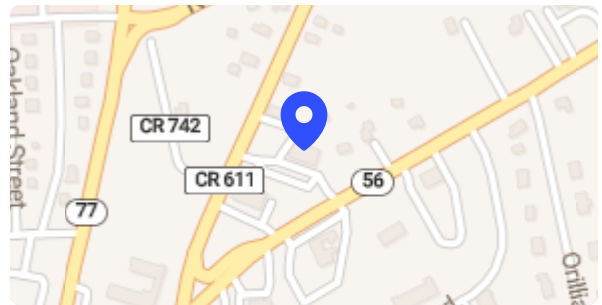

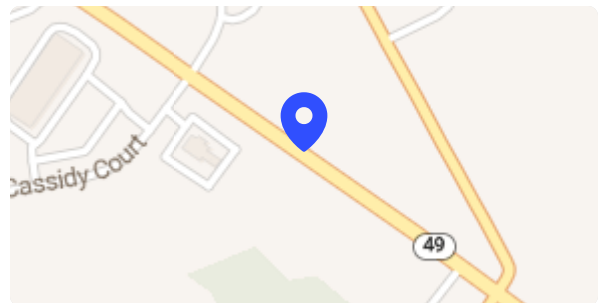
