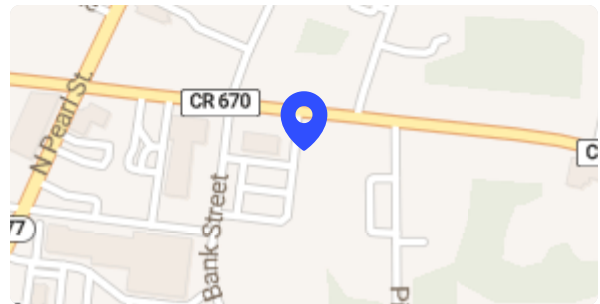
Mrs. Rainey was a retired teacher and an active member of St. Andrews Episcopal Church, Bridgeton, and a past officer of the Alice Felts Organization.

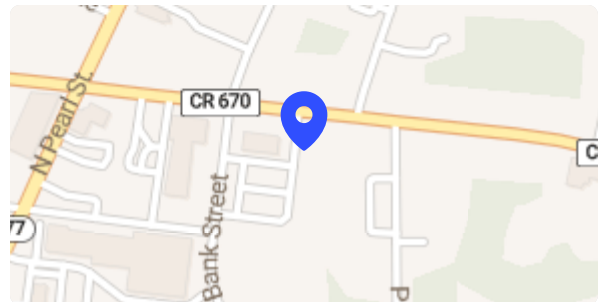
