**S**arah P. Rainey of Hammonton, passed away peacefully Sunday afternoon March 3, 2019 in Virtua Voorhees Hospital. She was 92 years old.

Born in Greenwich NJ September 11, 1926, she was the daughter of Ephraim Sr. and Rebecca (nee Loatman) Mosley, and the wife of the late Joe Rainey.

Sarah grew up in Greenwich and also lived in both Florida and Philadelphia. She was a former resident of the Hopewell Place Senior Apartments, Spring Oaks Senior Living in Vineland, and recently Heritage Assisted Living in Hammonton. She was a cosmetologist and owned and operated three beauty salons in Florida. She also taught cosmetology while in Florida at a Vocational School. Sarah was also a nurse, and did private duty nursing in both Florida and Philadelphia. She was formerly employed with Chestnut Hill Hospital in Philadelphia, and formerly worked as a news radio commentator with WDAS radio in Philadelphia, where her husband Joe was a Director of the station.
