John W. Pierce aged 68 years of Fairton, passed away at his home on Thursday March 21, 2019. Although he had been in failing health, his death was unexpected.

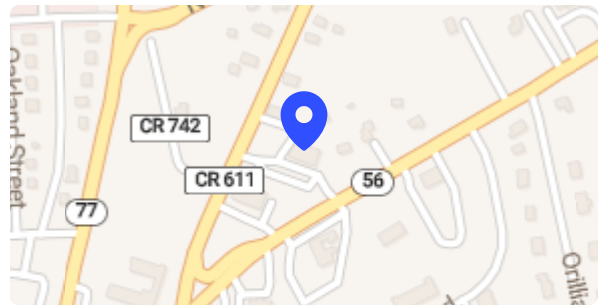

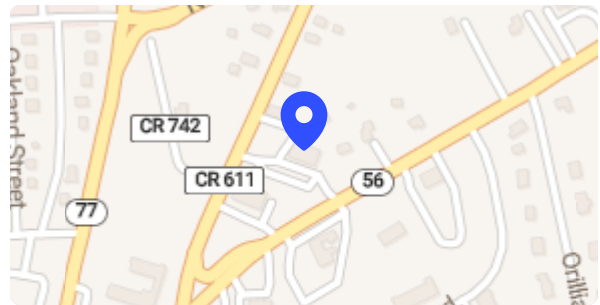

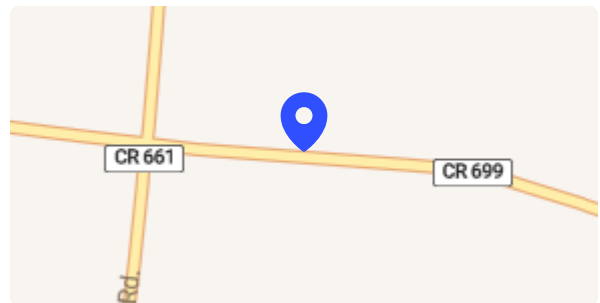
