**E**lsie L. Pierce, 81, of Deerfield Twsp. died suddenly and unexpected on Friday morning February 2, 2007 in Genesis Elder Care, Millville where she had been a patient under rehabilitation for two days.

Born in Newport, NJ she was the daughter of the late Hollie and Helen nee Jackson Saunders, and the wife of Herbert A. Pierce Sr. She and her husband were long time area residents of the Deerfield area.

Mrs. Pierce formerly worked at Owens Illinois on B Shift, and was also employed at the former Siebel and Stern factory in Bridgeton, and the Deerfield Twsp School System as a Lunchroom Aide.
