Jacob B. Caine, Jr. 63 of Bridgeton died peacefully Sunday afternoon April 29, 2007 in South Jersey Hospital Bridgeton - Hospice Inpatient Unit. He had been in failing health for the past year.

Born in Bridgeton, the son of the late Jacob B. Caine, Sr., and Frances Caine Ingles, he was the husband of Sharon nee Miller Caine.

Mr. Cain was employed for 26 and one half years with the Bridgeton Board of Education as a maintenance worker he was also formerly employed with the Cumberland County College, JOWA Security, the former Price Label Co., and Siebel and Sterns in Bridgeton. He was a former member of the Bridgeton Rescue Squad and was an avid CB radio enthusiast; his handle was the "Bewildered Bear".
