Wesley S. Thompson, Sr. 74 of Millville, died unexpectedly early Tuesday morning September 25, 2007 at his home.

Born in Cedarville, Lawrence Twp. he was the son of the late Howard Cuff Sr. and Amanda Thompson, and the husband of Joan L. nee Hayman Thompson. He had been a resident of Millville for most of his life.

Wesley was formerly employed as a mechanic for the City of Millville until his retirement.
