Janet J. Gilbert, 75 of Gouldtown passed away early Thursday morning March 5, 2009 in the South Jersey Healthcare Inpatient Hospice Unit, Bridgeton. She had been a patient there for the past three days and in failing health since January.

Born in Bridgeton, she was the daughter of the late Rev. Hubert Sr. and Dorothy nee Pierce Gould, and the wife of Ralph C. Gilbert Sr.; whom she would have celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary with on the 31st of this month.
