**N**orman P. Greenlee, 53 of Vineland died suddenly on Saturday March 27, 2010 in Cooper University Medical Center, Camden. He had been in declining health for the past 10 years.

Born in Norristown, Pennsylvania, he was the son of Clara nee Tate Greenlee and the late Norman P. Greenlee Sr., and the husband of Andrus nee Johnson Greenlee. Norman grew up in the Philadelphia area and attended Germantown High School. He was an avid Philadelphia sports fan following the Phillies, Eagles, Flyers, and Sixers.
