## **Dora Dee Durham**

JUL 31, 1957 - NOV 10, 2019

**D**ora Durham of Deerfield Twp. passed away on Sunday morning at her home under the care of Hospice, and with her family by her side. She was 62 years old. Born in Boston Massachusetts on July 31, 1957, she was the daughter of the late Ernest C. Jr. and Dora (nee Williams) Wynne, and the wife of Gary S. Durham.

Dee, as she was affectionately known, grew up and attended schools in the Vineland area and in 1975 joined the United States Air Force; serving proudly for ten years as a Medical Service Technician. 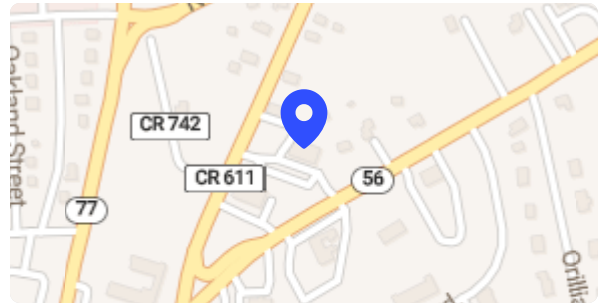

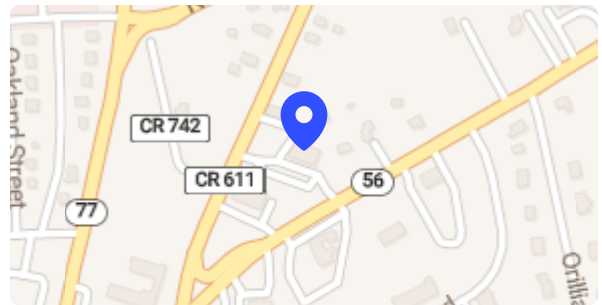

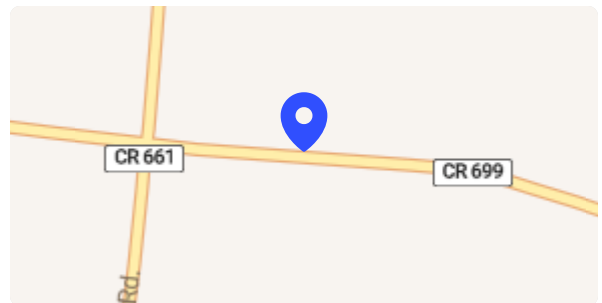
