At the family's request services will be private and burial of the cremated remains will be in the family plot in Fernwood Memorial Park, Hopewell Twp..

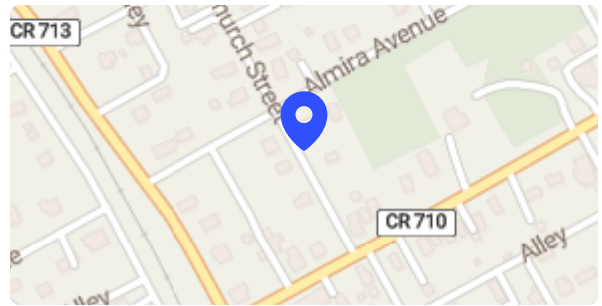
