# Eleanor Chinnici

OCT 27, 1918 - JUL 4, 2020

**E**leanor Chinnici of Upper Deerfield Twp. passed away Saturday evening July 4, 2020 at her residence, under the care of Heartland Hospice and with her family by her side. She was 101 years old.




Born in Philadelphia, PA October 27, 1918 she was the daughter of the late Filippo and Conchetta Martino D'Agostino. 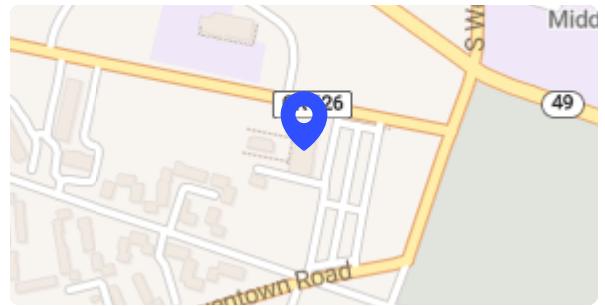

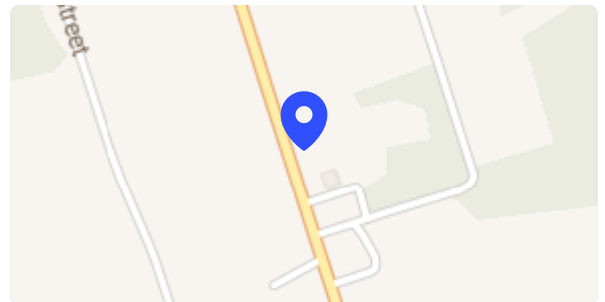

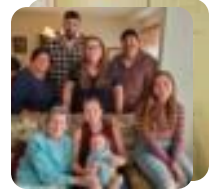
