Gary Bertram Moore-Bey age 65, the youngest son of the late Richard (Dick) Moore and the late Laura Isabel (nee Bunting) Moore went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday September 7, 2012 in Our Lady of Lourdes Medical Center, Camden, after a short illness.

Born in Salem, he was a lifelong resident of the Salem County area, and was educated in the Quinton and Salem county school districts. He was a 1965 graduate of Salem High School. He was a long time member of Haven United Methodist Church, which he joined at an early age.

After high school, he enlisted in the United States Navy where he was an E4 Corpsman assigned to the Marine Corp. and served his country in Vietnam. 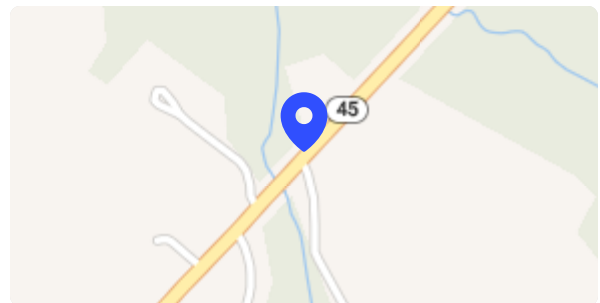
