# Margaret J. "Peggy" Cossaboon

FEB 20, 1953 - JUL 21, 2020

**M**argaret J. "Peggy" Cossaboon of Millville passed away late Tuesday evening July 21, 2020 in Inspira Medical Center, Vineland where she had been a patient for the past week. She was 67 years old. Born in Bridgeton, she was the daughter of the late Tilghman Daniel Sr. and Hester Ann Cuff Ridgway, and the wife of James "Buster" Cossaboon.

Peggy and Buster had just celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary on the 2nd of July.

Peggy was a Certified Nurses Aide and had worked for 28 years until her retirement for the former Bridgeton Nursing Center, now South Jersey Extended Care. 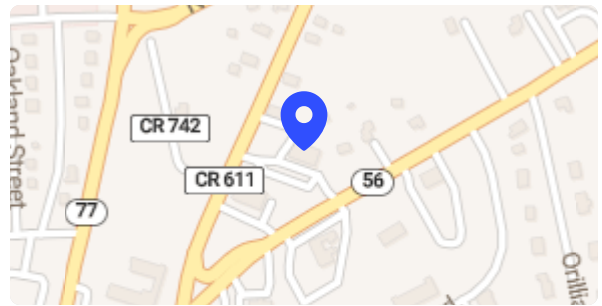

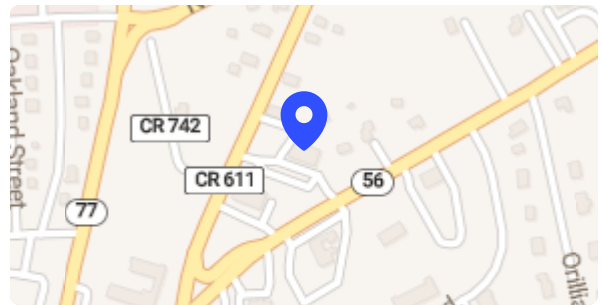

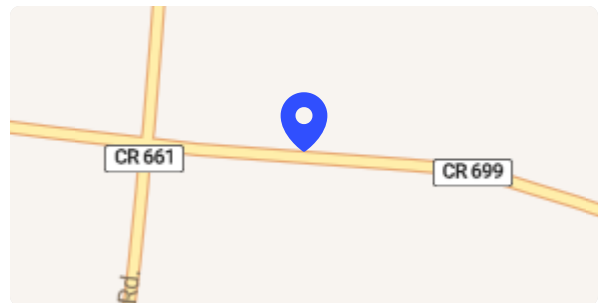
