Ronald Joseph Uhland Sr., 87, of Port St. Lucies Florida, formally of Bridgeton NJ, passed away Sunday, March 7, 2021 peacefully at home surrounded by his loving family and with his wife Phyllis at his side.

The beloved husband of Phyllis Uhland (nee Zurlo) was born in Roadstown, NJ and was the son of the late Joseph and Helen Uhland (nee Elk). One of twelve children, he grew up in Bridgeton and graduated from Immaculate Conception Regional School then Bridgeton High School in 1949.

In Ronnie's youth, he grew up working on the Uhland Family Farm in Hopewell Township and later enjoyed telling stories about time spent on the family farm. In his early years, he was an avid hunter and enjoyed spending time with his brother Jimmy training their racehorses at the Cumberland County Fairgrounds in Bridgeton. In his later years he looked forward to going to the horse races at Harrington Raceway and Dover Downs, as well as Greyhound Races at Palm Beach Kennel Club. Prior to moving to Florida, Ronnie and Phyllis looked forward to their annual vacation to Marathon Key with his sister Vi and brother-in-law Johnny.

Ronnie would tell you his greatest legacy is his remarkable family – the love of his life, Phyllis, 7 children, 20 grandchildren and 38 great-grandchildren. 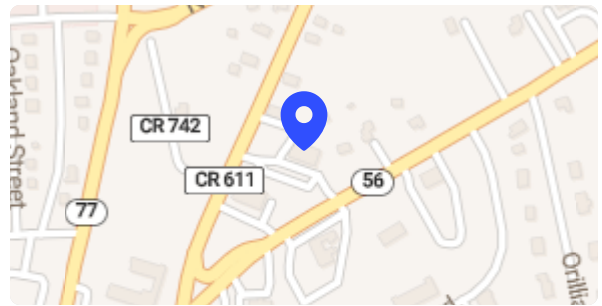

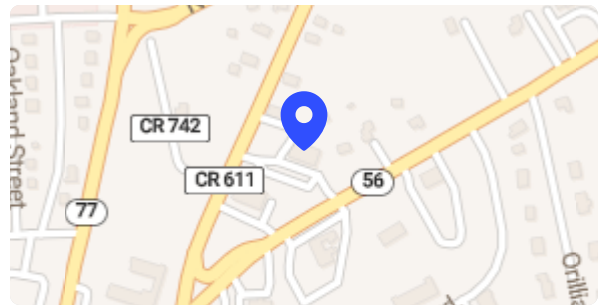

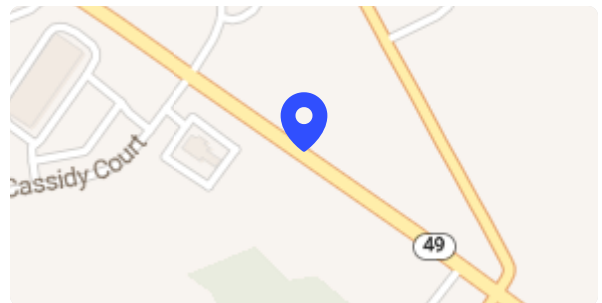
