Born in Bridgeton, he was the son of the late Raymond B. and Carolyn (Basetti) Newkirk and the husband of Heather (Eadie) Newkirk.

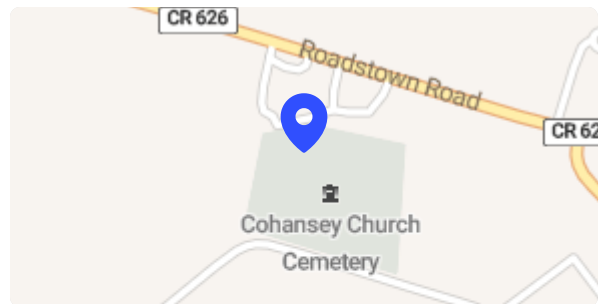
