June P. Ware, 97, passed away early Thursday morning April 22, 2021 in Inspira Medical Center, Vineland where she had been a patient for the past week. Born in Corry, Pennsylvania on August 3, 1923, she was adopted and raised by the late Leon and Pearle Scythes Perry, and was the wife of the late Budd N. Ware.

June had been an area resident almost all of her life, growing up and attending school in Hopewell Township and graduating from Bridgeton High School. After high school she worked for a brief time at the former MC Schrank sewing factory and also for Cumberland National Bank in Bridgeton. She gained employment with the US Postal Service where she served for many years until her retirement as Post Master of Deerfield Street Post Office in Deerfield. She was very active in her church, Deerfield Presbyterian Church, where she served on many committees and taught Sunday School. June was the oldest living member of the church. 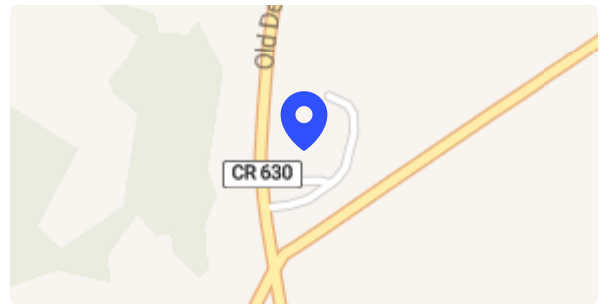
and nephews. Besides her parents and husband Budd, June was predeceased by her adopted brother Ray Leon “Jack” Perry and his wife Helen Perry.

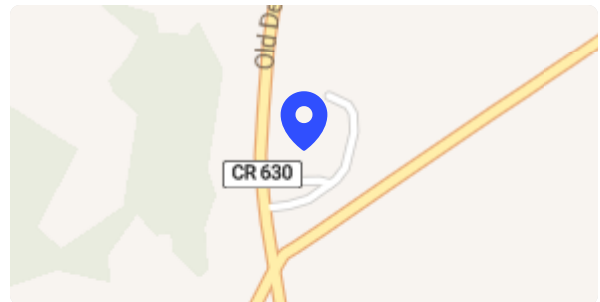

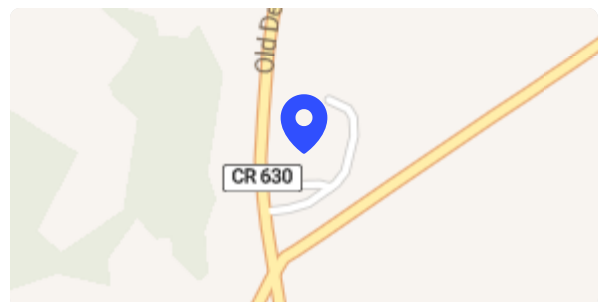
