Tilghman Daniel Ridgway Jr. 69, of Fairfield Twp. passed away on Saturday morning September 29, 2012 in South Jersey Healthcare Inpatient Hospice Center, Bridgeton. He had been seriously ill for only the past month.

Born in Fairton, he was the son of Hester Ann (nee Cuff) Ridgway and the late Tilghman D. Ridgway Sr. Danny moved back to the Fairton area in 1998, and had previously lived in Michigan and Tennessee.

Danny was employed as an Operating Engineer with Shul Mar Equipment Inc. and was instrumental in the building of marine transport cranes and equipment at many marinas up and down the eastern coast. He had a true passion for anything mechanical and was a member of the Wheels of Thunder Car Club. He was always seen at area car shows with one of his many antique hot rods. He also was an avid NASCAR, and Mark Martin fan, and loved spending time at the track with his brother Billy. He enjoyed fishing, playing golf, bowling, dirt bike motorcycle riding, and playing softball when he was younger. 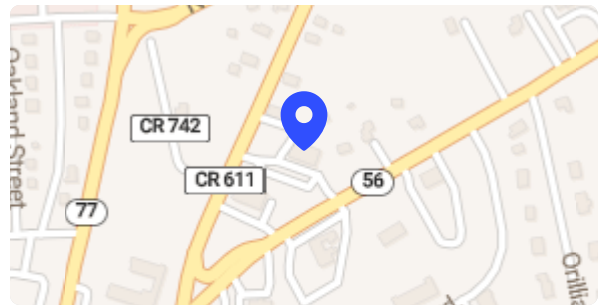

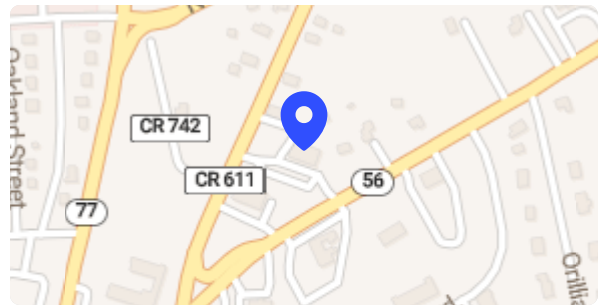

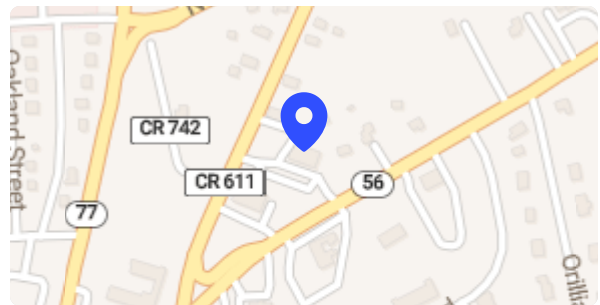
