**A**ndrea Velora Pierce (nee Canty), a pure spirit, passed away suddenly on November 29th 2021 in Bridgeton, NJ. She was 56 years old.

Andrea was born on the 4th of July 1965 in Brooklyn NY, and spent most of her life in Newark, Vineland and Bridgeton NJ. She is a graduate of Mount Vernon Elementary School, Newark, NJ, and Vineland High School, class of 1984. She also attended Cumberland Community College.

She was an energetic, active member within the Bridgeton Branch of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. She was fluent in Spanish, served a mission in Spain in 1987, and was the local Bridgeton church's Primary Leader for the church members' children at the time of her passing. She was also assistant to the Relief Society President at the church. 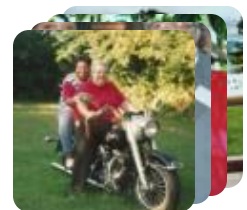

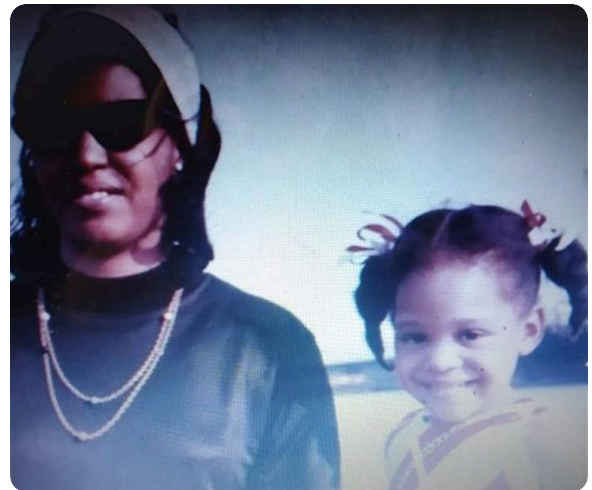
