Interment will be private at the convenience of the family.



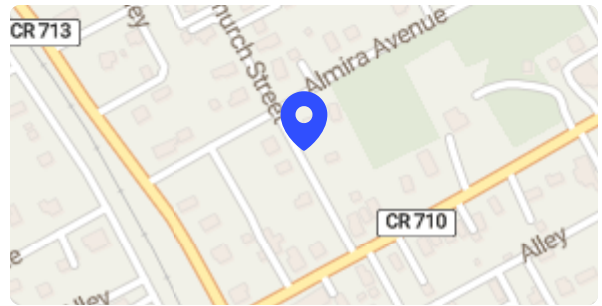
