Catherine “Quiet White Dove” Pierce, 94, of Fairfield Township crossed over peacefully surrounded by her children on Monday, March 6, 2023, in Inspira Medical Center, Vineland. She had been in declining health for the last 6 months.

She was born on January 15, 1929 to the late William H. Coward and Genevia Coward (nee Jones) and was the wife of late Leon J. Pierce Sr. who crossed over in 1967.

Ms. Pierce retired in 1991 from the Vineland Developmental Center as a supervisor. Previously, she worked at the Ancora Psychiatric Hospital, the Bridgeton Hospital, she had a newspaper route as a second job, and ran a convenience store next to her home, the Country Store, with her husband when they settled on the pike. In her free time, Ms. Pierce enjoyed bowling and was a part of a CB radio community in her younger years. 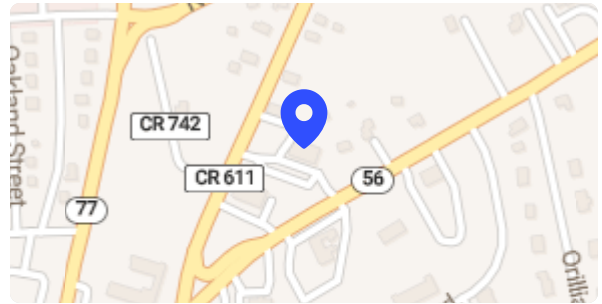

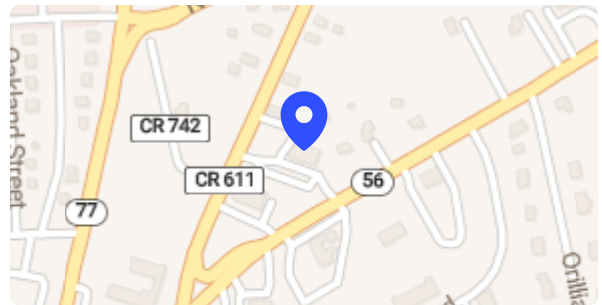
