**C**onstance Jan Yost, of Woodstown passed away suddenly Wednesday afternoon at her home in Friends Village Retirement Community. She was 77 years old. Born in Bridgeton, NJ October 4, 1945, she was the daughter of the late Paul Willem and Christine Marion VanderLoo, and the wife of her adoring husband James S. Yost, whom she celebrated their 57th anniversary with on June 11, 2023.

Constance was a graduate of Western Maryland College, and worked as a Social Worker for the State of NJ. She was a Certified Insurance Counselor with the Earle H. 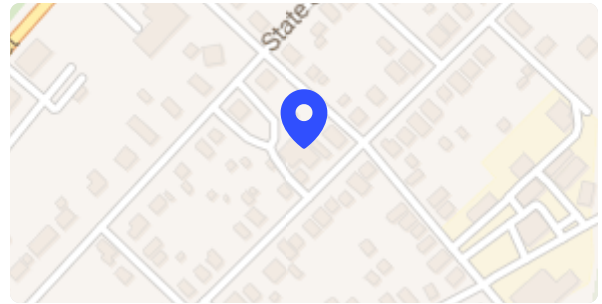

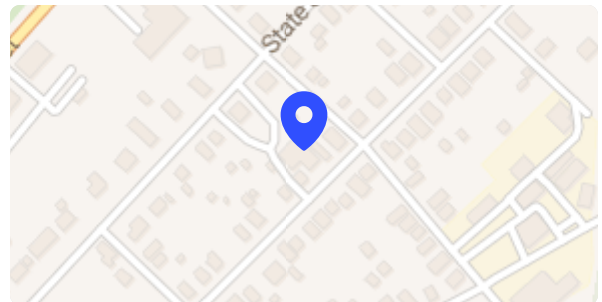

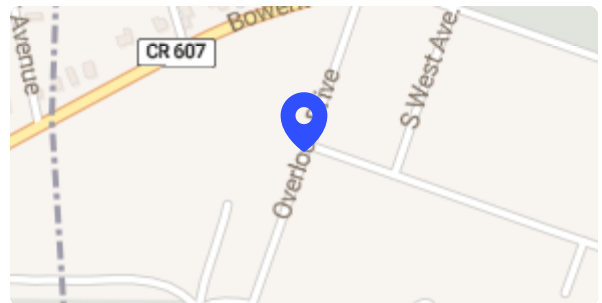
