**C**harlotte DiMatteo, 83, of Hopewell Twpl., passed away suddenly on Monday January 1, 2024 in Cooper University Medical Center after a brief illness. Born in Vineland, she was the daughter of the late Charles and Verna (Sharp) Battersby and the wife of the late Frank DiMatteo Sr.

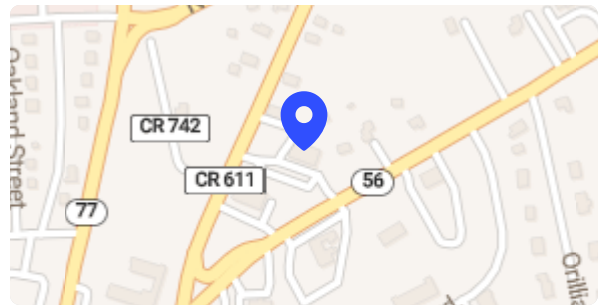

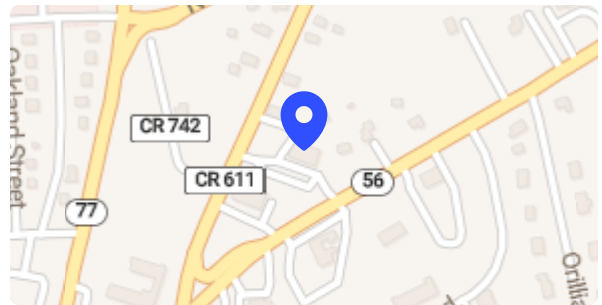

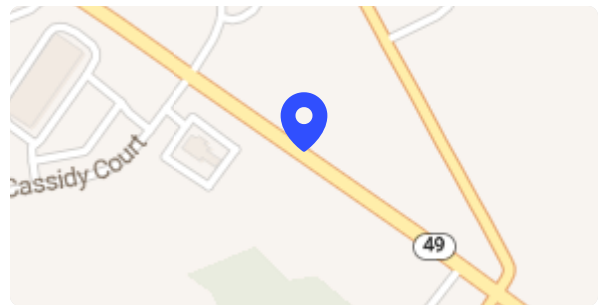
