Ricky T. Yamamoto, 65 of Millville, formerly of Seabrook, passed away on Thursday afternoon January 3, 2013 in South Jersey Regional Medical Center, Vineland, surrounded by his family.

Born in Bridgeton, he was the son of Utaka (nee Yasutake) Yamamoto, and the late Roy Yamamoto, and the fiance' of Deborah Robbins. Ricky was a Bridgeton High School graduate with the class of 1965. He was employed with Alcan Tubedraw in Millville as a welder for 16 years until his retirement in 2011. He also had previously worked for Kimble Glass Co. as a welder and metal fabricator, and the Welder/ Pipe Fitters Local 322 where he traveled working as a welder on several Nuclear Plants up and down the eastern coast.
