Frank J. Kammerer, 80, of Fairfield Township passed Monday, June 2, 2025 surrounded by his family. Frank was born June 6, 1944 to the late Violet (Steinbrecker) & Frank J. Kammerer Sr. in Philadelphia, PA. He grew up in Bucks County, PA graduating from Bensalem High School class of 1963, before ultimately deciding to serve his country in the US Army. Back then anyone wanting to find Frank knew to look for him at his family's business, Whale Creek Marina in Strathmere working, fishing, or out on his boat.

Upon returning from his military service, Frank began his career as a steel fabricator, where he spent many years working for Cornell & Company, INC. of Woodbury. Outside of career, Frank had a passion for Fishing, hunting, and practicing at the gun range. He loved being outside and spending time in nature conservancy. Frank stayed active by his many hobbies along with his volunteer work.
