Kristie Lynn Pierce, 48, of Millville, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, March 7, 2026, at Inspira Medical Center in Vineland. Born in Bridgeton on May 29, 1977, she was the beloved daughter of Major Pierce and the late Dianna Pierce (née Matthews). Kristie's sudden departure leaves a profound void in the hearts of her family and friends.

For many years, Kristie was a familiar and friendly face at the local ShopRite, where she served as a Customer Service Representative. Outside of career, she was a parishioner of The Parish of The Holy Cross and regularly could be found attending mass and other events at St Teresa of Avila Church. She also was a proud member of the Nanticoke Lenni- Lenape Tribal Nation and enjoyed attending the annual Pow-Wow and volunteering time to tribal events. She was a dedicated volunteer and found deep fulfillment in acts of service, constantly seeking out ways to uplift those around her. Her selfless nature made her a cornerstone of support for her family and the community alike.

She found particular joy in the bright resilience of sunflowers and the steady grace of turtles. Above all else, Kristie's heart belonged to her family. She would proudly tell anyone that her time was best spent in the company of those she loved. 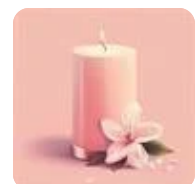
