



## Larry J. Durham

August 12, 1952 - May 31, 2020

Larry J. Durham of Deerfield Twp. passed away early Sunday morning May 31, 2020 at his home under the care of Hospice. He was 67 years old. Born in Bridgeton and raised in Greenwich, he was the son of the late Allen M. Sr. and Agnes Carney Durham, and the husband of Linda Nicholson Durham. Larry and Linda had been married for 35 years.

Larry grew up in the Back Neck section of Greenwich and attended the Morris Goodwin School. He was a 1970 graduate of Bridgeton High School and also attended Salem Technical School where he learned his skill as an electrician.
